

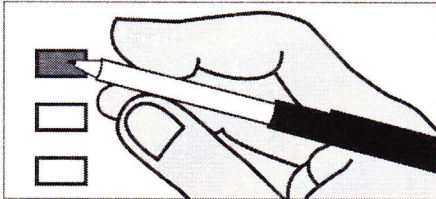

Amendment No. 63
